

# Warning of phishing emails

Dear AMAZONAS customers,

Fraudsters are currently sending fake AMAZONAS emails phishing for your data and intercept payments. In these emails you will usually be asked about your open invoices, with the request not to pay them yet, but to wait for our new bank details.

Unfortunately, fraudsters often work with the names of our employees, with our email signature or with our logo.

## How do you recognize such phishing emails?

- When responding to the email, the recipient is not AMAZONAS, but another email address
- We do not email you to send us a list of outstanding invoices
- New AMAZONAS employees unknown to you will never ask for your data. New AMAZONAS employees are always introduced to you by a well-known AMAZONAS employee

In case of doubt, please always contact your previous AMAZONAS contact person and do not simply transfer outstanding invoice amounts to a new bank account.
